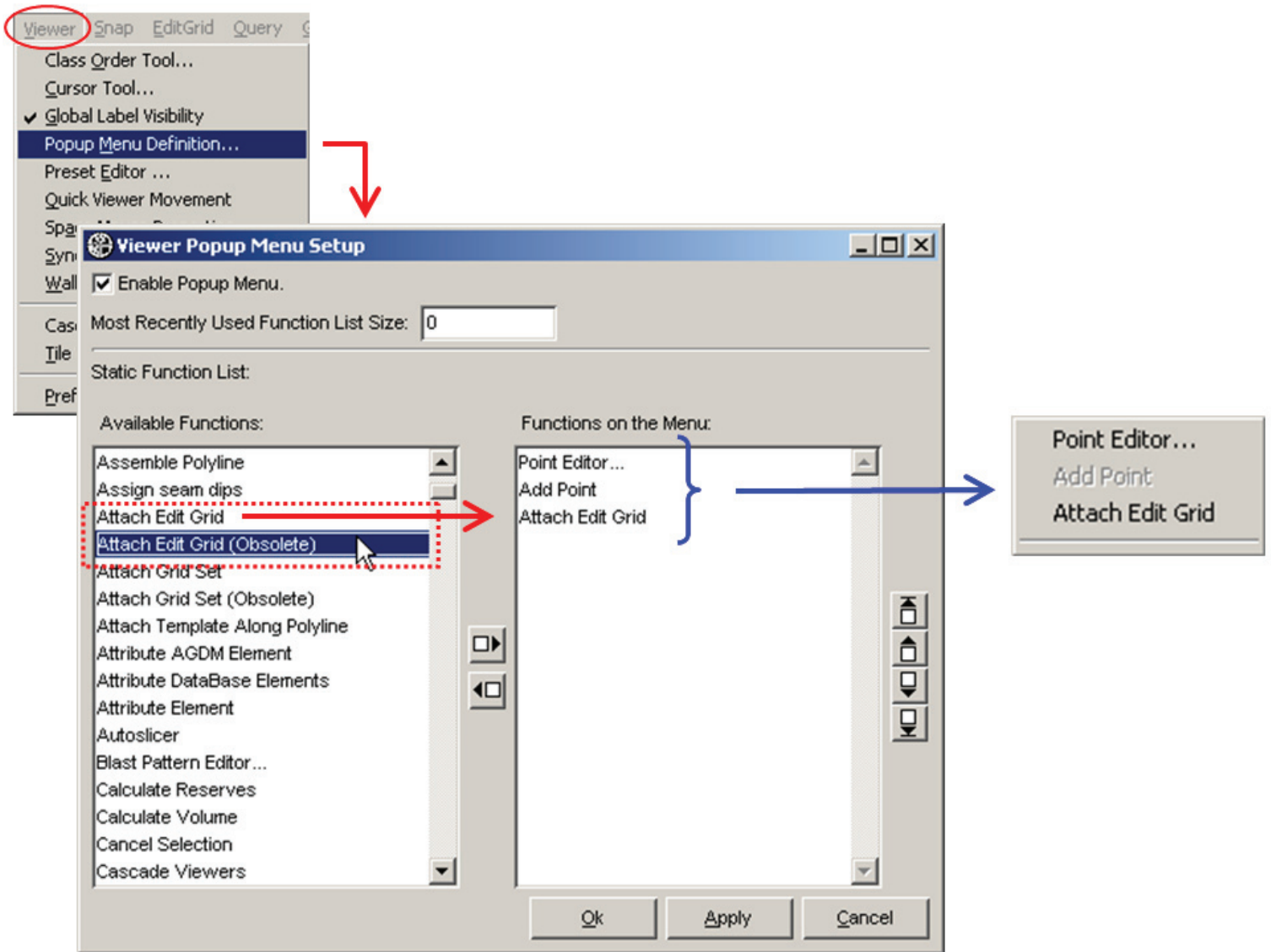


NOTICE: Check Your MS3D Popup Menu Definitions!

MineSight® 3-D (MS3D) version 4.50 introduced new functions governing viewer and camera position (e.g., Attach Edit Grid, Cascade Viewers, Set Camera Position, etc.).

If you have old versions of the functions selected on the static portion of **Viewer Popup** menu, they will appear with the word “Obsolete” (or “Depricated”) in parentheses beside the name. The “obsolete” versions will be discontinued in the future versions of MS3D. Please edit the popup menu definitions to select the new versions of those functions. The setup dialog for the Popup menu is found under the Desktop Viewer menu shown below.



The screen capture above shows the **Viewer Popup** menu (on the right), its **Setup** dialog, and how the **Setup** dialog is accessed. The functions on the **Popup** menu are selected in the **Viewer Popup Menu Setup** dialog. Notice there are some duplicate functions where one choice has “(Obsolete)” in the function name (outlined in red).
